

## Resolve an Ethical Problem

Conditions: Given FM 5-0, FM 6-22, DOD 5500.7-R, and a situation which requires you to make an ethical decision.

Standards: Implement a solution based upon sound reasoning and judgment in the application of an abbreviated Military Problem Solving Process to an ethical problem.

### Training and Evaluation Guide

#### Performance Steps:

1. Define the ethical problem.
2. Identify applicable laws, regulations and values.
3. Develop acceptable possible solutions.
4. Implement the best ethical solution.

### Performance Evaluation Guide

Evaluation Preparation: Provide individual with references listed below. Prepare a scenario that requires the individual to respond accurately, IAW task standards, to the following performance measures. This may be presented orally or in writing.

Brief Individual: Tell the individual that he or she will be required to correctly respond on all of the performance measures to receive a GO on the task.

Performance Measures	Results
1. Defined the ethical problem	GO / NO-GO
2. Identified all applicable laws, regulations, and values	GO / NO-GO
2a. Identified applicable laws and rules.	GO / NO-GO
2b. Correctly identified all appropriate ethical values	GO / NO-GO
2.c. Accurately determined all relevant guiding moral principles from the ethical values chosen	GO / NO-GO
3. Developed acceptable possible solutions that addressed the problem.	GO / NO-GO
3.a. Developed possible solutions	GO / NO-GO
3.b. Accurately applied all relevant information to the ethical problem	GO / NO-GO
4. Implemented the best ethical solution.	GO / NO-GO
4.a. Chose a solution which reflects sound judgment and analysis Selected the best method to implement their solution	GO / NO-GO
4.b. Selected the best method to implement their solution	GO / NO-GO
4.b. Accurately assessed results and modified the plan as appropriate.	GO / NO-GO

Evaluation Guidance: Score the individual GO if 100 percent of the performance measures are passed and NO-GO if less than 100 percent of the measures are passed. If the individual scores NO-GO on a performance measure, show or tell the individual what was wrong and how to perform the measure correctly.
